# MAKING AN IMPACT

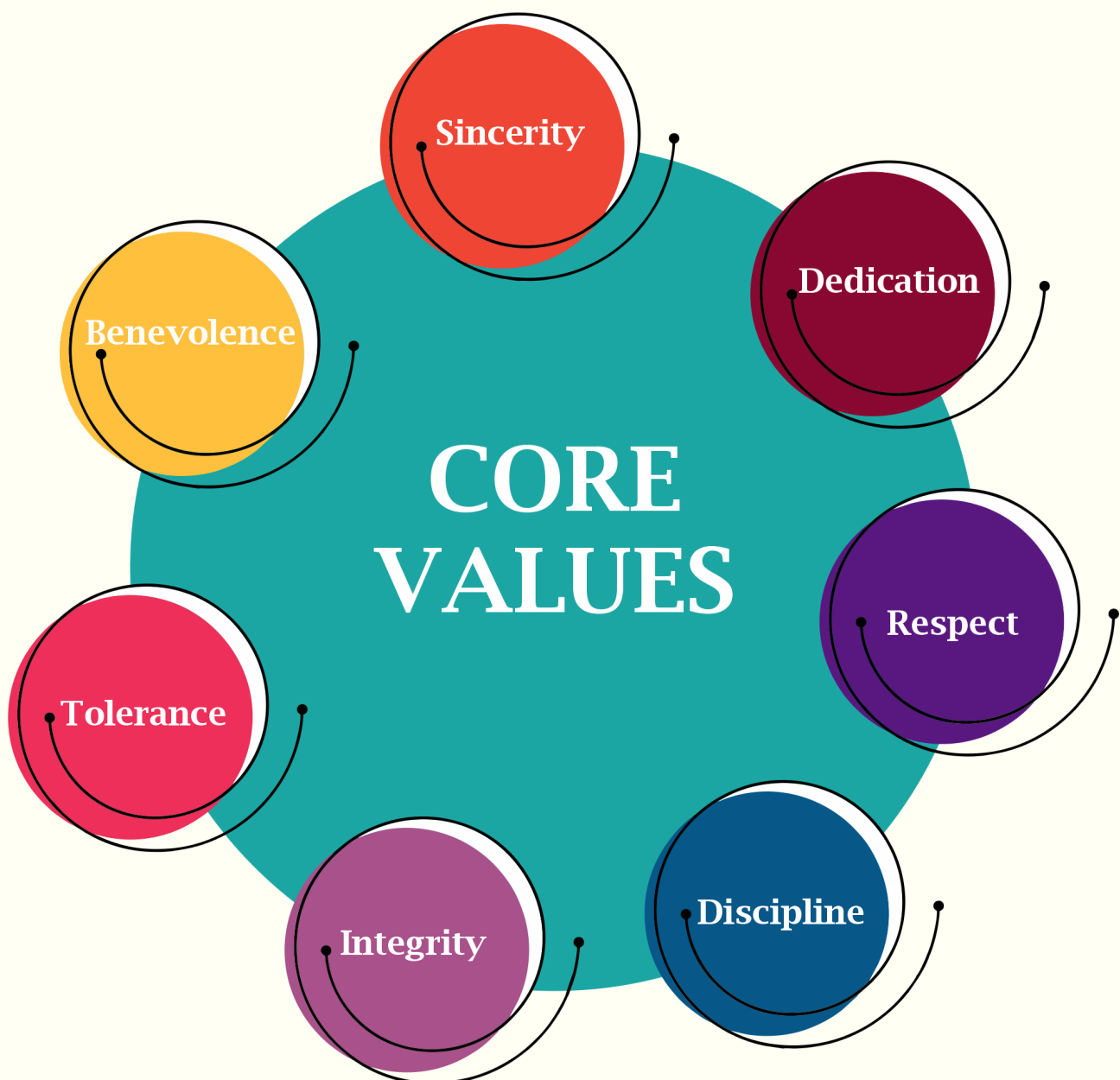


AlHuda Community Schools (ACS) is a part of AlHuda Schools Network running under the umbrella of Al-Huda International Welfare Foundation. ACS, a network of welfare schools currently operating at 1 branch in Islamabad and 8 locations in Lahore, is serving underprivileged children by providing them access to quality education and ensuring moral uplift. With classes from Montessori to Matric, ACS employs qualified staff and volunteers to provide opportunities for growth, success, high morals for every child of the community.

# THE IDEA OF REFORM



What started as a one-room school for the underprivileged children of Iqbal Town, Lahore in 2005 by a handful of people, soon expanded to other areas of the city. More and more children started benefiting. As the classes increased, the need for further professional supervision and academic support was felt for which these welfare schools were officially acquired by AIWF under the name of AlHuda Community Schools in October 2019. Thereafter, AlHuda Schools Network, a project of AIWF, is providing professional seamless support to ACS and is ensuring that these schools maintain high academic standards along with Islamic values.



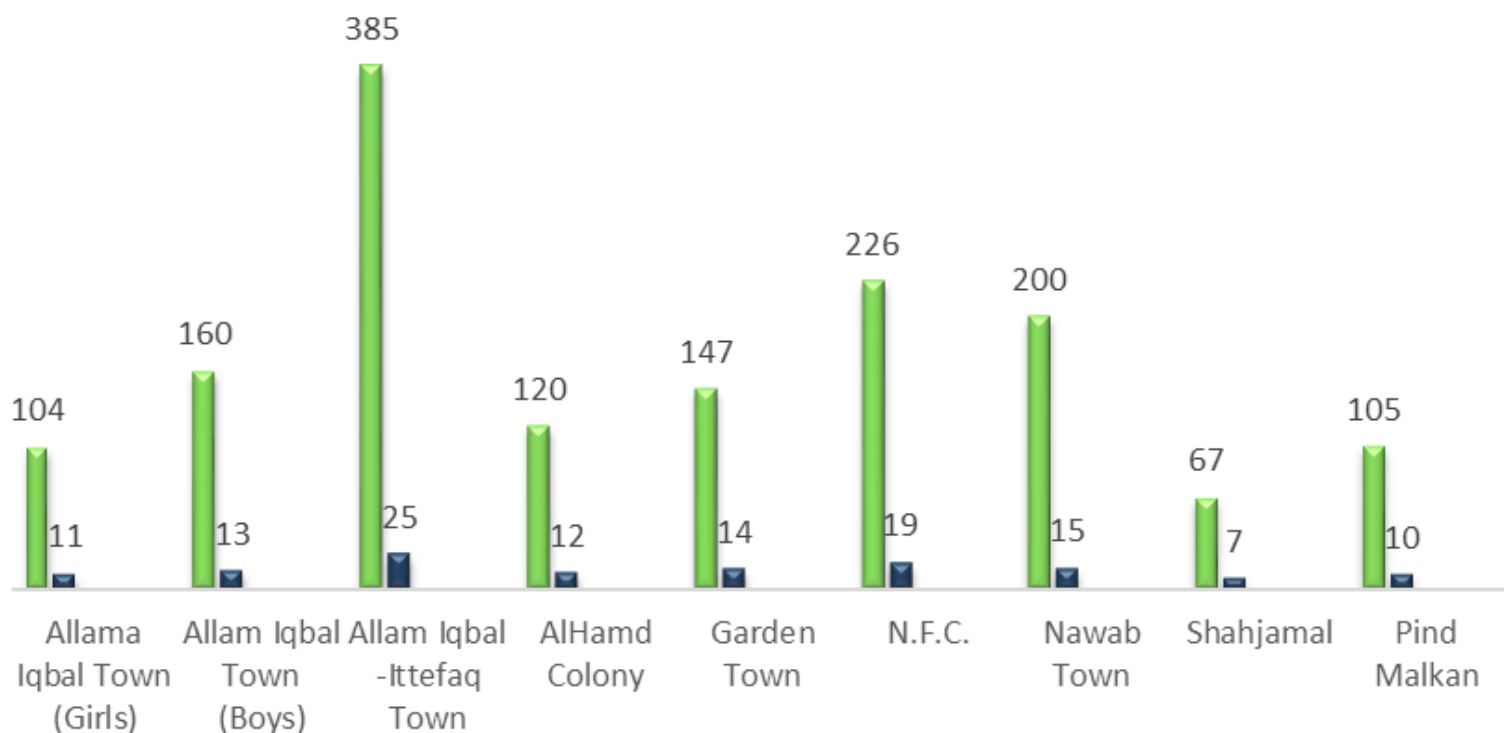

**Standardization of curriculum throughout all ACS branches**

All the branches of ACS are following the same syllabus.

This year we have switched to SNC PTBB from AFAQ Publishers.

**Standardization of School documents and procedures.**

All the ACS branches are following the same policies, procedures and documents provided by Head Office.

**Implementation of School Observations**

Frequent observations are made!

- Branch Observations by the HO on standard criteria's.
- Bimonthly Lesson Observation by Head Office team and the Schools Coordinator
- Ongoing teachers observation by the Principals and Schools Heads

This procedure is presently suspended due to COVID-19 lockdown.

Evaluation of School Heads by RO and HO is also part of the process.

**Regular Tarbiyah session for ACS staff**

Weekly Fehm-ul-Quran classes are held every Thursday for teachers, principals and janitorial staff. All our teachers and principals are registered with Islamabad Regional Office in AlHuda for Fahm-ul-Quran course.

In Ramadhan a short course of Quran Ke Moti was conducted. Akhlaaq e Husna class for Principals was also conducted.

### Training of ACS staff

- Guidance sessions regarding the policies and procedures of ACS
- Admission training for the standardization of admission procedures in all ACS branches
- Job Descriptions were explained and discussed with principals, coordinators, administrators and teachers by the Head Office
- Teacher training sessions were conducted this month for the subject teachers of ACS in reference to the Single National Curriculum
- SLP training was attended by ACS principals and Schools Coordinator in Islamabad for 3 days
- Zoom Meetings for the purpose of catering any queries by principals

### Tarbiyah sessions for ACS parents

Parental Workshops are arranged with the collaboration of Youth Club and Tazkiyah Foundation. Mothers' class is held bimonthly in all ACS branches. This is presently suspended due to COVID-19 lock down.

### Tarbiyah classes for students

Due to COVID-19 this includes listening to *Rugya Sharia* and recitation of morning supplications. Moreover, we are in the process of preparing level-wise activities for children based on moral values.

**Taking all the branches and principals on board for better coordination**

Regular meetings of principals and coordinators are held with the RO & HO for explanation of the new procedures and in order to motivate each other to perform better.

Principals are made subject Heads who guide teachers of all branches regarding their designated subject matter.

13 students have appeared for their Matric Board exams this year.

**Standardization of school events, and activities.**

All the events and activities are same throughout all ACS schools. School Heads are asked to take photos of these events and submit to the HO for fundraising/advertisement purposes.

**Maintenance of School Calendar**

A School calendar is prepared for every year/month, which is followed uniformly throughout each branch of ACS.

**Publicity or coverage of ACS on electronic media**

The PR team , HO and RO worked collaboratively for the projection of ACS on social media.

Youth club offered Tarbiyah classes for young ones. Youth club is working on Tarbiyah as well as personal grooming and communication skills of our children.

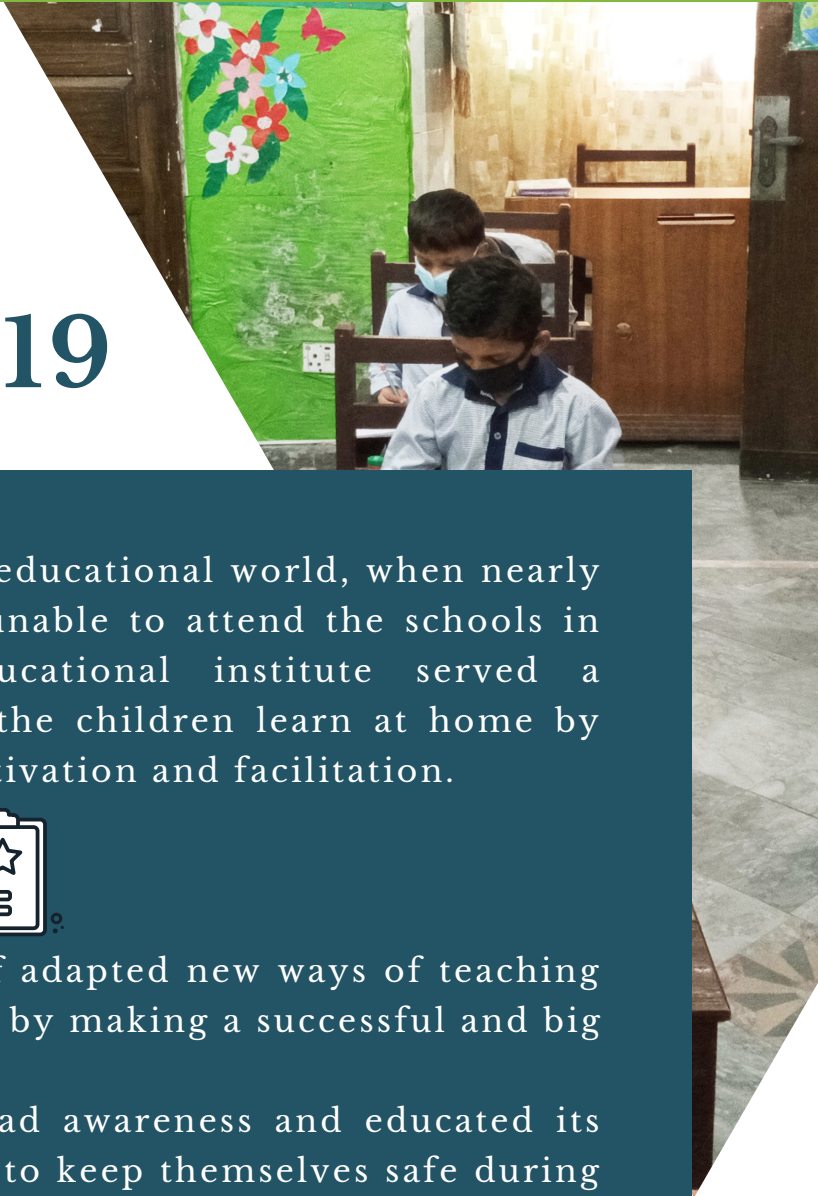
## 10. Charity Rights Visit

## 2. MOTIVATION:

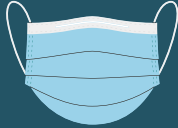
